CASCO will be resealing the track at Lowry Park next week. The track will need to be closed for 48 hours.

The bridge at King Park has undergone repairs this week.

Max Middendorf stated that the final pool payment request should be submitted before next week.

Mayor Hayden asked for input on meeting in the City Council Room. With Covid 19 cases on the rise in the county he said that we will have the conference call set up at each meeting and any Alderman, or other attendees would be able to attend remotely.

Mayor stated that an anonymous donor informed him that would like pay for placement of something under the swings at the parks to eliminate the holes that hold water.

Alderman Ritchart complemented Mr. & Mrs. Lowry on painting the picnic table area.

Alderman Ritchart noted that several neighborhood vehicles have not been inspected.

Alderman Grimsley asked about the pile of asphalt and concrete on the old laundry mat property. Tom Reinhardt stated the debris belongs to the property owner. Mayor stated that we would send a letter to the property owners.

Alderman Lennon stated that he would like an airport meeting to be set on Monday, August 24, 2020 at 4:30 pm to discuss Internet Connection.

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Economic Development Director, Ed Knight stated that he was able to obtain a change order on the radius of the corner of Mississippi and Washington Street.

Alderman Lennon asked about the status of the Street Lights, we are waiting for a return call.

Donnie Swartz stated that he owns property directly across the street from the property that he would like to withdraw from the City limits and that property is not in the city limits.

Alderwoman White moved to adjourn this meeting at 6:25 p.m.
